#### Conclusion

Across the three subjects analysed (English Language, English Literature, and Maths – Higher & Foundation), several key patterns emerge:

- 1. English Language Boundaries for top grades (9–7) remained largely stable, with slight decreases (~-1 to -2%). Lower boundaries (Grades 5 and 4) rose, with Grade 4 increasing over 7%.
- 2. English Literature Saw more noticeable increases, particularly in higher grades, with Grade 9 rising over 20% between 2021 and 2025, reflecting stricter thresholds in recent years.
- 3. Maths Higher Boundaries steadily increased across all grades, with Grades 7–4 showing 3–24% growth. Grade 9 rose modestly (+2.34%).
- 4. Maths Foundation All grade thresholds increased consistently. Grade 5 rose ~9%, while lower grades (1–2) grew ~15–18%. This suggests a general upward trend, making it slightly harder to achieve a pass or strong pass compared with 2022.

Overall, English Literature and Maths (both tiers) show more upward movement in grade boundaries than English Language. This indicates tightening standards and higher thresholds, particularly in Literature and Maths Foundation.
